

## **SEAWIND CLASS OWNERS ASSOCIATION**

### **Biennial Class Ballot – Process**

The Bylaws of the SeaWind Class Owners Association (SCOA) prescribe that the COA will conduct a Ballot of all members in odd-numbered years. Items for inclusion in the Ballot are, Election of all Class Officers and any proposals for changes to the SCOA Bylaws or Rules.

The procedures and timetable for conducting the Ballot are set out in Bylaw 1.6 & 1.7.

Procedure for nomination for any Officer position is set out in Bylaw 1.5.

Procedure for proposing any changes to the Bylaws or Rules is set out in Bylaw Section 5.

The deadline for receipt of any Officer Nominations and/or proposals for Bylaw or Rules change is currently to be postmarked before January 1 of the election year. However, as a practical matter, the ballot proposals are typically assembled during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of the preceding year and the Ballot package reviewed and voted on by Board members before distribution of the ballot package to members early in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of the election year. Submission of any proposals for change, to the Class Secretary, as early as possible will ensure proper consideration.
